


## **MID-COLUMBIA TENNIS ASSOCIATION 2024 ANNUAL REPORT**

MCTA is a registered non-profit 501(c)(3) in Washington State and are affiliated with the United States Tennis Association (USTA) as a certified Community Tennis Association (CTA). Our mission is to "To grow the lifelong sport of tennis throughout the Mid-Columbia community by providing equipment, opportunity, and resources."

### IMPACT


- MCTA Board of Directors grew to 9 members and established 6 committees.
- MCTA partnered with Piton Wealth as the exclusive fiduciary sponsor to help promote tennis in the Mid-Columbia region.
- MCTA had a strong year of giving back to the community, including:
  - Assisting 20 regional tennis programs (e.g., school tennis programs) impacting more than 500 student athletes year round
  - Donating tennis equipment to elementary and private school PE programs, middle school and high school tennis teams, nursing homes, churches, and the Special Olympics
  - Hosting 3 USTA sanctioned junior tournaments (Level 5, 6, 7)
  - Piloting USTA High School Tennis Program record-keeping software and provided feedback for future scorekeeping and community communications.

### **SUMMARY**

The following summary of contributions supported the MCTA mission by providing area schools and programs equipment, opportunity, and resources:

- Equipment
  - Over 200 racquets donated
  - Approximately 1,250 balls donated
  - 24 pair of shoes
  - 5 ball hoppers
  - 3 used tennis nets
  - Implemented the MCTA Fulfillment Request Form
    - Fulfilled 20 program requests
    - Served 565 youth tennis players
    - Served 20 tennis programs
  - Tennis stringer donated to area high school
  - Collected more than 300 equipment donations throughout year at our drop box locations
  - Initiated a ball machine check-out process

#### Figure 1 MCTA Tennis Program Fulfillment




Figure 2 MCTA Tennis Program Fulfillment Items

### • Opportunity

- 8 weeks of Special Olympics classes for up to 16 participants at Howard Amon Park by volunteer tennis instructor John Sands.
  - MCTA donated equipment: 2 hoppers, 10 racquets, 150 used balls.
- Provided 15 tournament scholarship waivers to area youth tennis players based on financial hardship
- Hosted USTA Level 7 Mid-Columbia Tennis Junior Spring Championships
  - 67 Junior Players played; first tournament for most
  - 45% percent joined USTA with a free account and eligibility for a free 3year membership!
- Hosted USTA Level 6 Mid-Columbia Tennis Junior Summer Championships
  - 85 Regional players across 6 states
  - o 15% joined USTA with a free account
- Hosted USTA Level 5 Mid-Columbia Tennis Girls' Summer Shootout
  - o 34 Regional players across 3 states
- MCTA Turkey Tournament 2024
  - 155 Players across 12 events
  - \$5,000+ raised
- Resources
  - Provided tennis racquet stringing training to area coaches and players

- Continued support of USTA Net Generation with school partnership agreements with three area elementary schools and registered two additional high school tennis programs; provided free curriculum to all area K-12 school participants.
- Provided Net Generations resources to Eastern Washington RecTennis programs
- Provided USTA Adaptive Programming curriculum to Special Olympics programs
- Developed an MCTA Fulfillment Request Form to handle requests (e.g., equipment, clinics, training, etc.)
- MCTA website resource updated and linked to USTA




Figure 3 MCTA Statement of Activity Summary
